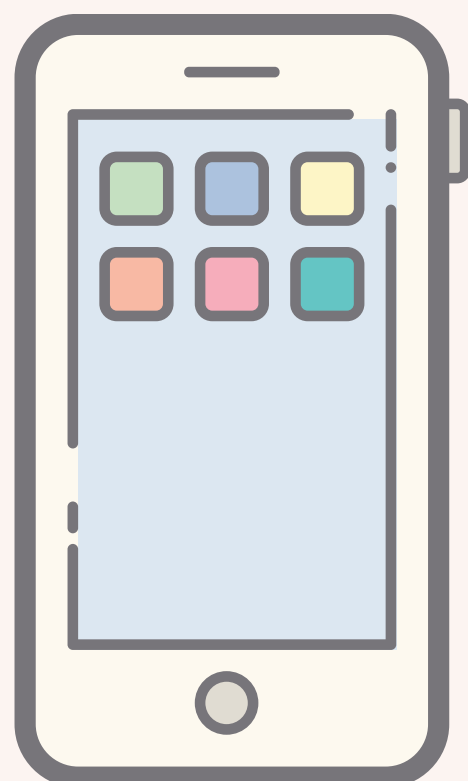


VCMS Chorus uses Remind 101

Remind is a free service that provides a safe way for teachers to text message or email students and parents.

How does it Remind work?

Once a teachers creates a Remind account, they are assigned a unique number. This number will be different from their personal phone number and is used solely for Remind. The teacher adds their class which generates a unique code that is shared with students and parents. At that point, any student or parent who sends a text message with the code will be subscribed to the teacher's class. Any time a teacher sends a message from Remind, all the students or parents subscribed will receive it.



How many subscribers per class?

There can be up to 150 parents & students in each class. So all parents/guardians/students can stay involved.



How much does Remind cost?

The Remind app is free for teachers to download. Parents & students do not have to download the app . . . just sign up! Remind is a free service for parents & students but standard messaging rates apply.



Will people see my number?

No. Your account is not attached to your personal cell phone number. You will be assigned a random Remind phone number when you subscribe and that is the number the teacher will see.



How do I sign up?

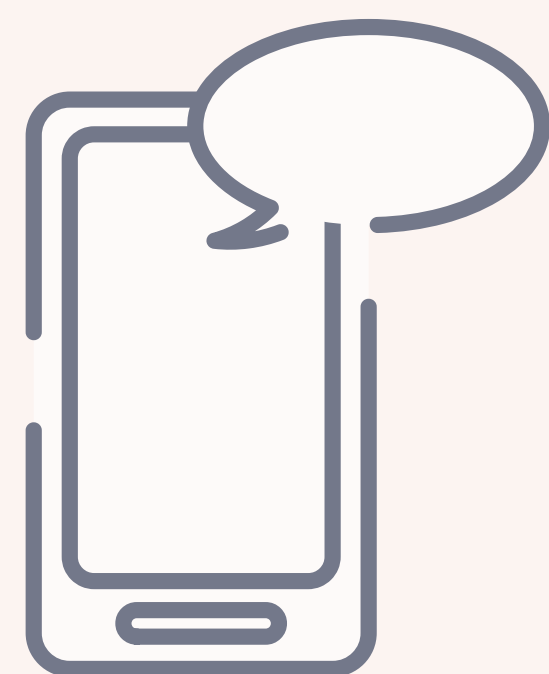
Send a text message with the class code to 81010 to receive text reminders.

Send an email with the class code to receive email reminders.



Will other subscribers see my messages?

No! That's what's great about this service. Teachers can send group reminders or announcements that are seen by all subscribers. Parents & students can reply to the message, but those replies are only seen by the teacher. Parents & students can also initiate questions without a message being sent first.
